

TO INSERT BATTERIES:
Using a Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included), loosen screws in battery compartment cover (screws remain attached to cover). Remove cover. Insert 4 x 1.5V AA alkaline batteries.
Replace cover and tighten screws.


FRIENDLY TIPS:
